# DARTFORD ORCHARD THEATRE

## Admission Policy

- The Orchard Theatre reserves the right, with reasonable cause, to refuse entry to our Pride events or premises, of any person, group, body or organisation or evict any person, group, body or organisation from the Theatre's and the decision to do so shall be final.
- The Orchard Theatre shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage suffered by any person at the Dartford Pride Event where such loss, injury or damage was occasioned by conduct on the part of that person or by failure to take proper and reasonable care whether on the part of the person who suffered such loss, injury or damage or such other person who was at the relevant time, responsible for that person.
- There will be a bag search on admission policy in operation. It is a condition of entry that you will submit to any reasonable search request.
- No glass will be permitted on the Theatre site.
- There is a 'zero tolerance' for illegal substances and legal highs at the Pride Event. Any person in possession of such substances will be denied entry and/or removed from the Event, and the Police will be called to attend.
- The following items are not permitted on the premises: portable laser equipment and pens, unauthorised professional film or video equipment, professional audio recording equipment, portable barbecues, air horns, spray cans, fireworks and flares, sky lanterns or anything that we consider could be used as a weapon.
- The use of drones/UAV is strictly prohibited.
- You are not permitted to bring into the event any amount of alcohol for your personal consumption. Any alcohol brought on site will be confiscated. We offer own drinks offering on site.
- CCTV will be operating throughout the Orchard Theatre site.
- The Event operates a 'Challenge 25' system at the bars, so if you are lucky to look younger than 25, please bring I.D.
- The distribution of literature e.g. flyers/leaflets without the consent of The Orchard Theatre is strictly prohibited and the Theatre reserves the right to confiscate the literature.
- Visitors consent to being photographed, filmed and recorded as visitors to our Pride Event and consent to the use any such film, image or recording at the discretion of The Orchard Theatre and Dartford Borough Council.
- Warning-Excessive exposure to loud music may cause damage to your hearing. Please note that pyrotechnics, lasers, smoke machines, strobe lighting or other special effects may take place during some performances.
- The billed music and attractions line-up and times may be subject to change at any time without notice.
- There will be photography and video recordings taken at this event. These images may be used for promotional purposes, in our publications and presentations and on our website [www.orchardtheatre.co.uk](http://www.orchardtheatre.co.uk). The images taken from this event may be used at any time, normally within a five year period, from the date of capture. If you do not wish your images to be taken and used in this way, please make your wishes known to a member of staff.
